The Waldwick Band's next concert will be on Sunday afternoon, March 10th, at The Village School in Waldwick. The concert will begin at 2:30 p.m. The Village School is located at 100 West Prospect Street in Waldwick, close to the Waldwick High School athletic field, and offers a fine auditorium with theater style seating for concert attendees. Parking is available on site and at the adjacent Forum School. There is no charge for admission.

The band will be under the baton of music director Edmund A. Moderacki who will open the concert with its 2018-2019 signature piece, John Centenaro's *Waldwick Band Festival March*. He will conduct the band in Frederick Breydert's *Suite in F* and Robert Sheldon's *Skydance*. Vaclav Nelybel's *Festivo*, selections from Lionel Bart's Broadway Show, *Oliver!*, and great marches are also programmed.
